## You Shall Not Take the Name of the Lord Your God in Vain

Introduction: "'The Name' is a figure of speech called 'synecdoche' which means 'a part of the

whole'. . . The name of the Lord your God refers to God Himself, to very

God" (Searle, And Then There Were Nine, 50-51).

You shall have no other gods before Me (worship the right God).

You shall not make for yourself a carved image (worship God in the right way). You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain (show respect for God).

**Background**: How we talk to and about God reveals our true heart for Him.

In vain: "empty of value, worthless"

**Conclusion**: How do you treat God?

Hollow – you have no respect for Him
